Sharon Dawe is a Professor in Clinical Psychology at Griffith University, Australia and an Adjunct Professor at the Australian Centre for Child Protection, University South Australia and an Honorary Professor, Warwick University. She has 20 year's experience in the field of substance misuse & mental health



Dr Paul Hartnett Paul is a Senior Lecturer in Clinical Psychology. He worked for six years at the Maudsley Hospital as a clinical psychologist in the fields of child protection and juvenile justice. He developed the Parents under Pressure programme in collaboration with Sharon Dawe.



Dr. Anne Whittaker is currently Associate Professor at the NMAHP Research Unit in the University of Stirling, Scotland, UK. She leads a number of applied research projects to test the feasibility of interventions to help drug-dependent parents and their families.



Dr Jo-Hanna Ivers, Research Fellow, Institute of Population Health, Public Health & Primary Care, Trinity College Dublin. As a researcher she has completed large-scale addiction studies including the evaluation of the National Drug Rehabilitation Framework.
