# Guidance for drug and alcohol support groups and treatment programmes

This guidance supports the safe resumption of drug and alcohol services under the national framework for living with Covid-19.



# **People**

living with drug and alcohol addiction are at higher risk from Covid-19



#### Hold

support meetings on-line or outdoors where possible



### **Support**

groups and treatment programmes are high risk settings when the incidence of Covid-19 is widespread in the community



#### **Venues**

should be airy and well ventilated



# **Maximum**

number of attendees is 15 people (including leaders), subject to 2 metres social distancing per person



#### **Face**

coverings should be worn at all times



# **Support**

groups should last a maximum of 90 minutes or shorter when the risk of transmission is high



#### **Attend**

only one support group or programme
